#### **Breckland Local Plan**

I'd like to thank all the villagers who turned up at All Saints' Church on Monday 1st February to listen to a Breckland Planning Officer explain why Bawdeswell had been nominated as a 'Local Service Centre'. The church was full proving that the village does care about its future in regards to building projects. I was very pleased to see the Breckland representative have to answer searching questions but be treated with respect.

I, like the vast majority of those present, was not convinced that we deserved to be a 'Local Service Centre' and that as an LSC we would be subjected to large scale developments. Our village has no doctors' surgery, a poor bus service, a school nearly always full, a congested main street and very little employment availability. It is difficult to understand how Breckland Council can think that makes our village suitable for increased property development.

I am sure the representative from Breckland left the meeting knowing the strength of feeling in the village. I also hope that sufficient villagers wrote/emailed Breckland to object to us being designated a 'Local Service Centre' so as to make them reconsider and prevent the ruination of our lovely village.

#### Are we worrying too much?

At the recent open meeting in Bawdeswell to hear Breckland Planning Department's suggestion for future expansion of Bawdeswell, there was strong opposition to the figure of 35 new houses over the next 20 years.

In the forty years we have lived in Bawdeswell, 90 houses have been built and if you go back just five more years a further 63 were built in the Hall Road development.

So the suggestion of 35 new houses over the next 20 years is a welcome reduction in the growth rate of the village in the past.

#### Conservation Volunteers' new project

The community volunteering charity TCV (The Conservation Volunteers) has received £39,000 from the Heritage Lottery Fund (HLF) for an exciting project, Themelthorpe's Natural Connections, in the middle of Norfolk.

Led by volunteers from the local community, the project focuses on improving wildlife habitats and access to the countryside at two significant sites of natural heritage - Foxley Wood and Mayfields Farm.

From 5th February, there will opportunities for people in the local area to meet new friends and learn new skills at any of a series of sessions which will run each Friday. There will be a mixture of practical tasks (such as tree care and restoring ponds) with learning to identify plants and animals. Participants do not need to be physically fit or have any previous experience - anyone over 18 can join in (16-17 year olds with parental permission). There will be a free minibus from Dereham town centre so that people without their own transport will have the chance to join in too.

The project's two main sites are only a mile apart. Foxley Wood Norfolk Wildlife Trust reserve is the county's largest ancient woodland. Over 350 flowering plants have been found here, including carpets of bluebells in Spring, and the site is also a haven for butterflies. Mayfields Farm is a 40 acre smallholding, owned by the Countryside

Enquiries have also increased and it seems that on at least one night a week all the rooms will be let on a regular basis.

The 50 new chairs that have been provided 'free' through a grant that David Cockburn applied for have been a great success. If we can raise enough funds in the future these are the chairs we'd like for the main hall.

It's wonderful to see work starting on improving the car park and we look forward to seeing this completed; it really will enhance the whole area. We know there is still much to do and funds to secure, but it's been a great start and everybody seems to be getting behind the project.

At our last meeting the trustees reviewed the updated project outcomes, change indictors and timescales form for the lottery and we are now pulling together our first mid-term report. These are very extensive but one of our obligations and requirements.





#### Bawdeswell Parish Council Meeting 1st February 2016

Present: D. Shannon (Chair), W. Mason, J. Lilwall, J. Mallen, T. Smith, R. Reed and B. Cunliffe, and Mrs. J. Boxall (Clerk).

Members of the public: 11

#### **Breckland Local Plan**

The main focus of the evening was on the draft Breckland Local Plan. Over 60 residents were present at a preceding public meeting with a Breckland District Council Planning Officer. The Officer provided information and answered questions on the draft Plan. Concern was expressed over access to the already stretched local services – school, doctors, sewerage system etc, as well as the already inadequate public transport service. The PC acknowledged that it was important to take into account residents' views. A draft response encompassing these views was circulated as a basis for discussion. The PC resolved by majority that 'The Parish Council strongly believes that Bawdeswell should not be designated a Local Service Centre' and that 'Bawdeswell wants a strong settlement boundary with little room for major development, but it is not averse to some limited flexibility in exceptional planning applications which seeks to promote the needs of the village.' A copy of the Council's full submission can be found on their website under News. Residents were encouraged to submit their own individual views to Breckland before the deadline of 22nd February.

#### **Recreation Ground Car Park**

The PC discussed the urgent need to refurbish the Recreation Ground car parking area. Following the recent bad weather and increased usage the area has deteriorated and desperately needs attention. Thanks were expressed to Andrew Toomey, for all his work in researching solutions and obtaining quotes which were circulated to Councillors for consideration. The PC resolved to allocate the sum of £11,000 from general reserve to the budget for the refurbishment. As it was recognised that it would be necessary to seek further donations and obtain grant funding (which would delay the project), the remaining funds from Project Bawdeswell would be made available for any temporary and separate repairs to help ensure the safety of recreation ground and village hall users.

## "A Shackleton Odyssey"


2016 marks the 100th anniversary of the dramatic rescue by Sir Ernest Shackleton of his crew from the *Endurance*. Shackleton's epic journey into Antarctica in 1914-1916 has been described as one of the most astonishing feats of exploration and human courage ever recorded. The expedition's boat, the *Endurance*, was first trapped in the ice and then crushed before sinking; after which the party camped on ice-floes until they had to make their onward journey to Elephant Island in three lifeboats. From here Shackleton and five others completed the 850 mile sea passage to South Georgia in the 22 foot long lifeboat *James Caird*. On landing on the wrong side of the island he and two others crossed the glaciers of South Georgia eventually reaching Stromness from where the successful rescue of all of his men began.

This lecture by Roger Smith, a Fellow of the Royal Geographical Society, tells the story of an Aurora Expeditions' party, of which he was a member. 95 years later (in 2011), they retraced some of the original journey. After visiting the Antarctic Peninsular, an ice-strengthened boat, the *Polar Pioneer*, moved to the position where Shackleton's party took to the lifeboats in the Weddell Sea. From here it closely followed the original route to Elephant Island and South Georgia, where a successful crossing following Shackleton's route from King Haskon Bay to Stromness was made, with two nights spent camped on the glaciers.
