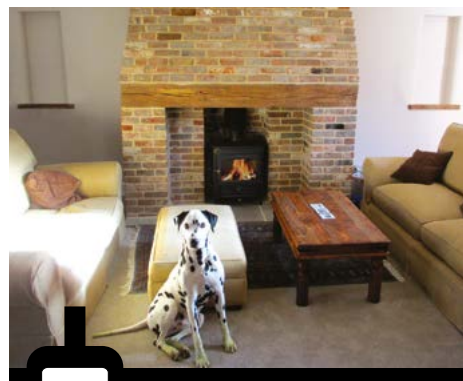

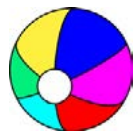

Book Club

“His Bloody Project: Documents Relating to the Case of Roderick Macrae” by Graeme Macrae Burnet



When the Book Club met to discuss this book it was a hot evening following a very sunny and hot July day. Discussing this book took us all into a very different place.

Very quickly we were there, in 1869, in a very remote Scottish village where life was very harsh, with little to alleviate a miserable existence. The villagers were embroiled in the aftermath of a brutal triple murder.

The book is brilliantly constructed by the author. There is the murderer's own testimony, different witness statements and reports of psychological assessments. Unlike some other books, this one starts with the murderer confessing his guilt, so it doesn't have the 'who-did-it' question, instead this book is concerned with whether the murderer was sane at the time of the murders, or not.

The murderer gives a vivid account of his life in the village of Culduie, near Applecross. It's so clear that you can feel, almost taste, the salt in the air from the shore and certainly feel the despair of the crofters who live under the direction of a harsh constable who particularly bullies the murderer's family.

The murderer is only seventeen. Is his testimony reliable? As the witness statements and the psychological assessments unfold, it seems that maybe it's not... Will insanity save him from the gallows?

All through this review I've talked about 'the book'; it seems so real, such a factual piece of writing, we all struggled to remember this is a piece of Fiction! No wonder it was shortlisted for the Booker Prize in 2016.

The Book Club meets in the 'Lounge' outside the Workhouse Bar on the first Thursday of every month at 8pm. We mostly obtain books from the library so there is not the expense of buying new books each month. We are currently reading "My Name is Leon" by Kit de Waal for discussion on 2nd August. Our future books for the summer are "The Report" by Jessica Francis Kane for discussion on 6th September and "Elizabeth is Missing" by Emma Healey for discussion on 4th October. Happy reading! 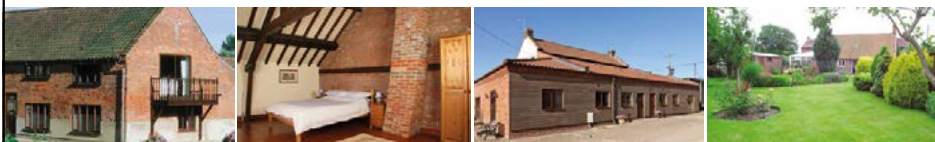

CHURCH NEWS

Church Letter

Dear Friends,

One great privilege and joy I have in my role is to be regularly involved in the lives of two of our schools. To be a small part in the children's journey as they move from year-to-year, all the time growing and learning, and 'becoming' the people whom God intends them to be.

I have a couple of recent experiences which I would like to share with you.

The Year 1 children of All Saints' Stibbard CEVA Primary School paid a visit recently to Stibbard Church. They had been learning about the different features of the church, such as the font, the altar, lectern, pews etc. They explored the church and drew some pictures, followed by a 'question and answer' session. They asked all sorts of questions - about the age of the building, how I became a vicar - but they seemed most interested in the churchyard. How many people are buried there and what happens to us when we die? I was greatly moved when one boy expressed the hope that, one day, he and I would meet again in heaven!

Perhaps the most moving event of the year is the Year 6 Leavers' Service. It's a sort of 'bitter-sweet' time - all the excitement, and probably some nervousness, about starting High School; combined with a genuine sadness at leaving their primary school, which has nurtured them and opened up so many opportunities for them to thrive. It's also the occasion to present awards - five children at North Elmham CEVC Primary School achieved 100% attendance, and there were awards for excellence across the curriculum. Not a 'subject', so much, but a value that is at the heart of our schools, and one which I hope the children will carry with them into their adult lives.
