





Book Club "Exposure" by Helen Dunmore



'Exposure' was written in 2016 but it is set firmly in the early 60s and successfully conjures up a time of twin tubs, coal fires and freezing bedrooms. Politically it is the time of the Cold War and a time of keeping secrets, as the establishment is still reeling from the defection of the spies Burgess and MacLean.

Giles Holloway works at MI5, where his superiors are in "the habit of making allowances" for him, so for some time he has been able to take home Top Secret documents without comment. However, a bad fall leaves him incapacitated and if he is not to be caught out he urgently needs to get the file back to the office. He calls upon his friend and colleague Simon Callington to help.

Simon is a happily married man with a family but whilst at Cambridge he was 'friendly' with Giles. Simon collects the file and takes it home where his wife disposes of it. Simon quickly discovers that he is 'no good at this sort of thing' and the security services soon catch up with him and he is arrested and sent to prison.

There are many echoes of 'The Railway Children' in this novel, but it is an altogether darker tale than the much loved E. Nesbit children's book. I felt that Simon's wife, Lily is the strongest character in the novel which deals with how she and the children, Paul, Sally and Bridget, cope with the accusation that Simon is a spy.

I really enjoyed the novel, it is a gripping tale and many of us found it a real page turner. Some found the ending rather predictable but the story is fast moving and most of us found the characters are totally believable.

The Book Club meets in the 'Lounge' outside the Workhouse Bar on the first Thursday of every month at 8pm. We mostly obtain books from the library so there is not the expense of buying new books each month. We are currently reading "Fingersmith" by Sarah Waters for discussion at our meeting on 6th December. During the festive period we will read our 'Secret Santa' books and will discuss these at our meeting on 3rd January. New members are always welcome.

WW1 memorial bench

The WW1 memorial bench was ordered at a cost of £889.00 plus VAT. An additional donation of £59 was promised. PC agreed unanimously that they would contribute the remaining funds of £60. It was agreed that the WW1 bench should be placed on the village green and that one of the existing benches would be moved elsewhere. A huge 'Thank you' to all those who donated towards the bench. It is hoped that the bench will arrive by the end of the month.

Churchyard wall/Tree Survey

A tree survey is due to be carried out on 8th November, and the report to be circulated to Council once received. No further information was received regarding the work required to the church wall. It was agreed to obtain further quotes for comparison.

Parish Partnership Scheme and speed limits

Despite further emails to Highways to chase, no information had yet been received about the possibility/costs of extending the speed limit around the school. It was acknowledged that it was now too late for the PC to apply for Parish Partnership funding this year but that the information should still be obtained for future grant funding schemes.

PROPOSAL: Development of three detached self-build properties with garages

LOCATION: Dereham Road, Bawdeswell

PC agreed unanimously to object to the application as proposed by Cllr Cunliffe. It was acknowledged that the site is outside the settlement boundary and previous similar applications have been rejected. There are inadequate visibility splays for highway purposes and no adequate provision for pedestrians or people with disabilities has been made, contrary to that shown on the drawing. There had been an accident recently in that location. There is no local need for housing following approval for 40 dwellings in Bawdeswell.




