

VILLAGE NEWS

Bawdeswell Parish Council

This is an update on the planning permission granted for 40 new dwellings to be built on Two Fields Way. Permission was eventually granted on 23rd March 2018 with a condition that building work should commence within 2 years of that date. However, the developer who was granted planning permission has sold the building site to Abel Homes.

I have contacted the managing director of Abel Homes who has assured me they intend to clear the rubbish then fence the site to prevent further fly-tipping on it. They intend to apply for further 'slight' alterations to the dwellings. The Parish Council will monitor the negotiations between Abel and Breckland Council regarding any changes.

For the information of the residents in the vicinity of Two Fields Way, who will suffer the most disruption when building work commences, I do not expect building work to begin until late summer. The new owners are legally bound to begin work on the site any time before March 2020, but unfortunately there is no constraint regarding the date of completion.

I understand that Abel Homes are a local firm with a good reputation. As soon as there is any further news regarding this site, I will pass it on and keep you informed.







Bawdeswell Church News

The recent national advertisement for a Team vicar to join the Heart of Norfolk Benefice, of which we are part, failed to attract any applicants. This is the third attempt to fill this post. Where do we go from here?

In order to manage such a large group of parishes more lay support will be needed, not less as is happening, and if not forthcoming a joint PCC will need to be formed. We need to prepare ourselves for this and the introduction of more Group services on Sundays. The latter are perhaps harder to persuade people to support. The majority just won't travel.

Having said this, it was well worth attending the Group Service at Guestwick on Sunday 29 April, commemorating the sacrifice of Guestwick men during that month in WW1. The church was nearly full, which was a joy in itself, and we had an inspiring sermon from visiting army Padre John Vincent, then enjoyed a local exhibition and refreshments afterwards.

Only the Tower remains of the small Saxon Church. It appears that the Church was initially rebuilt around 1200 and was then substantially rebuilt again in the 15th century. It has become primarily known for the very unusual location of its Tower which is now on the North side of the Chancel.

There is a delightful modern stained glass window in the North-West corner of the Nave, expertly crafted for the Millennium by a resident of the village, and the monumental brasses here form one the best collections in the county.

A reminder of our local heritage and well worth visiting. The service, the welcome and the fellowship were great too.

A new colour guide to all of our 13 churches has been published and is to be launched at a Reception at Bawdeswell Village Hall at 7.30pm on Thursday 28th June. All welcome. See elsewhere for details.
