

LETTERS John Howard Parfitt

My father was born 29th July 1933 the first child of Alec & Ruby Parfitt, fruit farmers in Billingford. He has 2 brothers, Peter & Richard.

He and both brothers went to King Edward VII Grammar School in Kings Lynn where they all played Cricket & Rugby and most others sports.

After School he went to Chadacre Agricultural Institute, Suffolk. Here he played Cricket & Rugby. At times when they were young all three boys and their father played cricket together.

My Dad did his National Service in Driffield, Yorkshire and played cricket for Driffield. He also played Cricket for his beloved Norfolk and represented the county at Rugby of which he was immensely proud.

Dad was very much a 'Son of Norfolk & the Countryside'. After his National Service he came home to work on the family fruit farm in Foxley which was his life.

He was a big shooting & fishing man; his knowledge of birds and the countryside was second to none, a knowledge that he has passed onto his grandchildren. He was such a proud grandad of Tom & Sarah, and a huge influence on them too.

He married my mother Maisie in 1960. They were married for 55 years 10 months, before Mum died suddenly in January 2016: a huge shock for all of us, in particular Dad, as he was totally lost without Mum. The last 4 years have been very tough for him without his treasured Maisie.

Dad and his brothers Peter & Richard were still very close and spent time together whenever they could. The 3 sisters-in-law were close also and this resulted in many parties - lots of loud laughter, recalling most of the cricket matches ever played, pheasants shot or large salmon caught!!

Dad and Mum were in Reepham Young Farmers many years ago, and their circle of friends have been amazing, for 60-65 years. They were so lucky to have such a wonderful group of people,

We had a small cremation for Dad at Breckland Crematorium, but it was extremely comforting & flattering for Tom, Sarah & I to see so many people line Mill Road, Foxley as the cortege came through. Thank you.



PARISH COUNCILS

MEETING OF BAWDESWELL PARISH COUNCIL HELD ON THURSDAY 2nd JULY 2020 AT 7.30pm HELD VIRTUALLY BY ZOOM

Present: B Cunliffe (Chair), J Lilwall, A Hartley-Walder, K Ewing and R Reed Mrs. J Boxall (Clerk) Members of the public – 2

A Toomey and District Councillor G. Bambridge sent their apologies. County Councillor B. Borrett and the Police were not in attendance.

Village Hall Car Park

Four areas were highlighted for consideration:

1) Overflow Carpark – A permeable pavement carpark such as Bodpave is proposed to allow the area to remain green but still be trafficked.

2) Existing Carpark Drainage – Design of a new French drain to capture the additional carpark surface water and soakaway.

3) Additional Parking Bays – The design of additional parking bays adjacent to the main entrance which could be either a permanent asphalt or permeable solution.

4) Surface Repairs – The current surface of the carpark has disintegrated and methods were being investigated to improve the surface and reduce maintenance.

Following discussion, the Council agree to accept the Engineer's quote to produce layouts and specifications to allow a contractor to quote to undertake the works for items 1, 2 and 4 at a cost of £2100.

Recreation Ground

From the 4 July, children are once again able to play on the play equipment, but the council is keen to remind people that social distancing continues to apply.

Both children and adults should continue to stay 2M apart from people outside their bubble wherever possible, avoid touching their face and not share equipment. They are also being asked not to eat or drink in the play areas and to stay away if they or anyone in their household feels unwell.

As it isn't possible for us to keep all play areas sanitised, visitors are being advised to bring their own wipes to clean the equipment alongside their hand sanitiser. Any used wipes should be placed in the bins provided or taken home if the bins are full.

The clerk explained the proposal to **re-wild part of St Thomas' churchyard**, between the church tower and the boundary with Vine Cottage in an area that is not visited.




