A Message from Crime Prevention

It's the time of year when we start to see an increase in reports of thefts from cars, sheds and outbuildings. As the nights draw in and the weather becomes chilly we are all guilty of sometimes settling down in the evening and neglecting to check if our outbuildings, vehicles and homes are properly secure and these lapses can be seized upon by opportunist thieves taking advantage of insecure doors, windows and stealing valuables which are left out or on show in vehicles.

The #9pmRoutine is an initiative backed by many Police Forces both in the UK and abroad which seeks to encourage residents to get into the habit of completing routine security checks. By setting a reminder on your phone or your alarm for 9pm you'll get into a routine of checking your home, vehicle and any outbuildings are secure and valuables removed or hidden out of sight. Opportunist thieves look for an easy target, by completing the following checks life will be made all the harder for criminals

- Check your vehicle
- Shut your windows
- Lock Your Doors
- Check your Outbuildings





Rotary recovery fund tops £2,500 as more grants are made

The Reepham Rotary Recovery Initiative is designed to support local organisations who have been stretched by the current pandemic as they get back to work following the recent restrictions on activities. The total donated to date has topped £2,500 and the first grants have been agreed.

As well as substantial members' contributions, the club has welcomed donations from a wide range of residents and businesses. It is hoped that many more businesses and individuals will contribute as word spreads.

The fund has agreed to pay £500 towards materials to refurbish a mobile classroom for use by the school chaplain to provide much needed counselling for High School students. It will also pay £450 towards the cost of new storage facilities for use by organisations at the Bircham Centre.

According to Reepham Rotary's Roy Sherlock: "We have heard from other organisations and we are considering two other grants already. There can be no doubt that there is a big need in our community and it will only grow as restrictions continue."

More money needed

The initial target for the fund was £2,500. However, it is clear that there is a bigger need. While many people have financial worries, others may find they have spare cash through less travel and shopping. The Rotary Club hopes to divert that money to where it is needed. The Club is considering other projects to support the fund, although some lateral thinking is required to come up with ideas that can be put into practice in the current restrictions. They would welcome cooperation with other groups who share their aims.

Bawdeswell Village Hall



November was a funny month. First, we were open, then we weren't, but we will re-open as soon as restrictions are lifted.

Many thanks to all our Volunteers who helped us restart our Hub Café. We changed our opening day so that we could use the Main hall to maximise social distancing and our Volunteers made sure that everyone was waited on!

We applied to the Norfolk Community Foundation Winter Resilience Fund in our quest to improve our Covid-19 secure facilities even further. We wanted to invest in equipment that would safeguard everyone even further.



We are delighted that we have been successful in securing a grant of £4,379. This grant must be used specifically to support our Hub Café. We plan to upgrade with 'sneeze guards' and barriers to help people move safely around our building and other people. Disposable tablecloths may have seemed an extravagance, but they will help us reduce contact between people.

Trustees continue to work together. Our risk assessment has been fully reviewed. We have instructed our solicitor to move our assets and contracts to complete our move to CIO (Charitable Incorporated Organisation) status. We continue to follow all the government guidelines in maintaining a safe environment for our users and consequently we have closed the hall during this second 'lockdown'. Of course, being closed means that we have no income from hirers whilst the Hall still has costs that must be met. Trustees continue to work together to ensure that our outgoings are minimised and we are grateful to have received a further £1,334 from Breckland's Local Restrictions Support Fund.

When we are allowed to re-open, our Village Hall will again, be open for business:

- ➤ Hub Café will open each Thursday 10:00-12:00* for tea, coffee and cake
- Updated information about exercise classes* will be posted on our website. Prebooking is essential for all classes, please see further details on our website www.bawdeswellvillagehall.co.uk



Drawings and projected costings for work to improve the drainage, provide an overflow car parking area and to repair the existing surface in the Village Hall car park were received and circulated to council for consideration. It was acknowledged that the project would need to be funded through a loan from Public Works Loan Board (details of which were circulated) which will require full consultation with the community. It was agreed that the Council would form a working group to consider options with a view to progressing the scheme once current restrictions are lifted and consultation can take place.

A meeting with Norfolk Wildlife Trust has been arranged to seek their advice on future maintenance of Adams Pit. A quote has been received for the maintenance of the Churchyard and Jubilee Gardens, further quotes are expected.

Finance

The precept will be considered and approved at the December meeting. The precept is the parish council's share of the council tax. The precept demand goes to Breckland District Council, who collects the tax for the Parish Council. The 'Precept' is converted into an amount per Council Tax Band that is added onto the Council Tax bill.

Church Letter

Dear Friends,

I am writing this on the 9th November, the day on which Pfizer and BioNTech, the pharmaceutical companies, have announced the development of a vaccine for Covid 19.
