














#### **WELCOME**


#### **Reepham Gardening Club**

#### More about Bawdeswell



#### The Bell Inn

Former Georgian Coaching Inn which in 1823 became a staging post on the Norwich to Fakenham Turnpike. Closed in 1970 and converted

into flats. *Coaching Routes* listed in 1811 - Lynn to

North Walsham, by Litcham, Reepham, Cawston and Aylsham. *Stopping at Bawdeswell Bell* 

Cromer to London by East Dereham, Watton, Brandon, and Newmarket, Stopping at Bawdeswell Bell.

(So you could get a coach at Bawdeswell for London.)

#### The Willows (former Ram Inn)

This building has little external appearance of antiquity but is late medieval and 17th Century. Former timber frame surviving to first floor of east side only.



Many other interesting features confirming its antiquity.



#### **Church View**

Formerly a workhouse, then school, then bakery and shop, a blacksmith and finally a home and a public bar.

Parishes used to be responsible for looking after their poor and this building was where

they were given a roof to live under, and were put to work. In 1836 several Parishes formed a Union and built a larger workhouse at Gressenhall to accomodate all the poor of the area.



#### **Moated Sites**

From the Reeve's Tale - June 1998

The Moats in **Foxley** are the site of a Manor House and farmstead dating back to somewhere between 1100 and 1500.

The Norfolk Heritage Explorer says: "In 1305 during the 14th century, the manor of Bigod is recorded in documents. The site of this large manor may be in Foxley. A large rectangular medieval moat can be seen on aerial photographs taken of the parish and it has been suggested to be the site of Bigod's manor."



Foxley Manor is recorded as being granted by Henry II (1154 - 89) to Sir William de Munchensey. Bawdeswell and Sparham were part of the Manor too.

By 1700 it was in the hands of the Lombe family, whose descendants today live in Marlingford Hall. The area adjoining it is still privately farmed, so if you are tempted to have a look at it on one of your walks, please do keep to the edge of the field.

The site is quite dramatic.

MEETING OF BAWDESWELL PARISH COUNCIL HELD ON THURSDAY 4<sup>th</sup> JUNE 2020 AT 7.30pm HELD VIRTUALLY BY ZOOM

District Councillor G. Bambridge sent his apologies. The Police were not in attendance.

#### Village Hall Car Park

Following a site meeting, a report is expected to be produced setting out possible options for managing the problem of the flooding in the village hall car park and lack of car parking on occasion. It was acknowledged that a plan to finance any improvements would be required.

#### **Recreation Ground**

The new play equipment has now been installed. Although it is frustrating that the play area remains closed under current government restrictions, an official opening is proposed for later in the year. Thanks were extended for all the generous donations received which has enabled this fantastic play equipment to be installed. THANK YOU!

#### **Finance**

The balance of the community account after May payments was £26,518.74. The balance of the business money manager was £2258.64, Project Bawdeswell account was confirmed as £3331.90 (ringfenced for play equipment).

Recycling credits were received - £264.15 for glass and £220.93 for textiles. This money is reserved for community grants so applications are invited from community groups needing funding. A copy of the grant funding terms and conditions can be viewed on the website. Grants are considered at Council Meetings following receipt of application. As no requests were received for grants 2019/20 this money was put towards the play equipment.

#### **Church Letter**

Dear Friends,

We have welcomed the very good news that our Church buildings can once again be open for individual prayer and 'small' funerals, we long to be able to welcome visitors back to our churches as COVID restrictions are gradually eased. However, we are taking a measured and gradual approach to reopening, in fact very few of the church buildings in the Heart of Norfolk Group 'qualify' for re-opening at this time.

The Government guidance on the safe use of places of worship includes the requirement to operate a 'one-way' flow in and out of the buildings, which means that our single-aisle churches do not qualify. These are: Bawdeswell All Saints; Foxley St Thomas; Twyford St Nicholas; Wood Norton All Saints; and Worthing St Margaret.

Even where buildings have two or three aisles, it is not such a simple issue as opening our Church doors at a stroke. A lot of preparation has to take place to maximise the safety and well-being of all who may enter our churches, and they are complicated buildings, as Archbishop Justin Welby said at the very start of lock-down.

For one thing, we have to pack-away any items that people may touch, such as hymn-books, visitor guides, kneelers, children's toys and all printed material. Cleaning is a major issue, given that most of our regular cleaning-teams are volunteers who fall into the 'at-risk' groups, and should not be exposing themselves to the risk of contamination.

Other church buildings which must be kept closed for the time being, as building contractors are on-site are: North Elmham St Mary, Foulsham Holy Innocents and Stibbard All Saints. We hope to be able to open these churches when the works are complete.
