

ANDY BATTLEY 1945 - 2020

Andy Battley died peacefully at home on 21st September 2020 after a long illness.

He was a clever, mild mannered gentle man and was an enormous asset to our village.

With his wife Shirley he moved from London in 1987 to take over 'The Top Shop', the shop we all now know as The Bawdeswell Store. They were a formidable team and together they transformed a small village shop into a thriving popular modern store.

It became the best-known village store for miles around and in 2005 they were runners-up in a nationwide 'Neighbourhood retailer of the year' contest and also won a 'Village Store of the Year' award.

They were miles ahead of other local stores with their on line shopping offering a choice of over 10,000 items from their web site. They always listened to their customers and in the unlikely event that they did not have in stock what you wanted, they certainly would do the next time you went in.

The Bawdeswell Store sponsored the Bawdeswell Boys Football Team and kitted them out with new football outfits which they were proud to wear.

In 2007, Andy and Shirley retired having run the store for 20 years.

He also served on the Bawdeswell Parish Council from 1990 to 2003, much of the time as Chairman. He served with distinction during a period that saw the sale of the ex-army hut which was our village hall, the sale of the land it stood on, and the purchase of the current recreation ground and the building of the new village hall.

Andy was a fighter, he fought to make Bawdeswell a good place to live in, he fought to provide the best possible village store you could have, and so it was no surprise that when illness struck, he fought that for many years.

It was a fitting tribute to see so many people lining the route at his funeral and to see the store he loved closed as a mark of respect as the funeral procession passed on route to All Saints Church, Bawdeswell.

He will be sorely missed but never forgotten. Bill Cunliffe

I would like to say a big thank you on behalf of me and the rest of the family for turning out for Andy's funeral on October 8th. It was very moving to see so many of you lining The Street and outside McColls (Bawdeswell Store which we loved running for 20 years) and to them for closing whilst we went past. It meant such a lot and Andy would have been so chuffed.

It is such a shame with the COVID restrictions that you couldn't all come into the church and join us afterwards to celebrate his life but as that wasn't possible, we feel the send-off we gave him was very fitting and it's a comfort to know he is just around the corner in the cemetery. Special thanks to Bill Cunliffe, Robin Taylor, James Lilwall and Father Christopher for the help they gave us and allowing us to do it our way.

Andy loved his time in Bawdeswell - being a country boy at heart. When we moved up from London in 1987 and bought the Store, he was never happier than when he was helping someone with either deliveries to them or ordering in products for them that we didn't currently stock. He loved the community and threw himself into village life by joining the Parish Council (later on Chairing it) and being on the School Governors or just walking Cassie and then Meggie, our dogs, down the lane.

I'm sad that our retirement was not what we had anticipated when he had the stroke in 2006 and then having to sell the Store in 2007 but it gave us 13 years of being together properly. I treasure that time as we were able to spend quality time together for the first time in a long while, and I grew to love him even more than ever doing everything together.

I miss him so much but know he's at peace because near the end it wasn't any sort of life he was having. So rest in peace my darling until one day we meet again.

Autumn at Bawdeswell Bowls Club Green.

Autumn is the most important time of the year because what we do know makes a big difference to next season. Starting things off, we spray sulphate of iron to burn off the moss before we start removing the thatch by verti, cutting three or four times. removing about forty barrow loads then we run the mower over to clear loose trash. Next job to do is spike to about three inches with small finger tines followed by over seeding with 'barenbrug bar' range of grass seed mixtures, then with a tonne of topdressing to repair any bare patches, finishing with two bags of winter fertilizer. The green will be mowed four or five times throughout the Autumn and Winter and deep spiked every three to four weeks.

Then in Spring we start preparations for playing the next season. If interested in playing on a first-class green, the home of Bawdeswell, Bintree and Lakeside Bowls Clubs.





MEETING OF BAWDESWELL PARISH COUNCIL HELD ON THURSDAY 1st OCTOBER 2020 AT 7.30pm HELD VIRTUALLY BY ZOOM

Present: B.Cunliffe (Chair), J. Mallen, J. Lilwall, A Hartley-Walder, A. Toomey, K. Ewing, R. Reed, Mrs. J Boxall (Clerk) Members of the public – 0. District Councillor G. Bambridge, County Councillor B. Borrett and the Police were not in attendance.

Grounds Maintenance in Bawdeswell

Councillors visited all the sites in the village with a view to creating a final grounds maintenance schedule for the village. Several options were presented for consideration. Following discussion, it was unanimously agreed to leave the recreation ground contract as it is and obtain quotes for the Churchyard and Millennium Gardens, to seek further advice from Norfolk Wildlife Trust regarding Adams Pit and exclude Adams Pit from the maintenance contract at present as proposed by Cllr Cunliffe. Once the current maintenance contract has ended, it was agreed that all locations should be joined in one contract.

It was agreed that the Parish Council noticeboard be repaired / renovated and moved to the left-hand side of the Jubilee Garden arch so it is not so obscured.

Finance

The balance of the Community account as at 30th September was confirmed as £17,528.00, Business Money Manager was £2258.74, Project Bawdeswell account was confirmed as £ £3,313.90. An invoice had been sent to Foxley for their contribution to the Community Car Scheme £235.94. Due to current restrictions, lack of journeys being made and demand, it was unlikely the second grant payment would be made by Breckland.

Highways confirmed that they 'do not authorise the placement of mirrors on the highway to assist with visibility as they can dazzle drivers and affect the ability to judge the distance of oncoming traffic. If an unauthorised mirror is found on the public highway it will be treated as an obstruction and removed.'

Royal Mail have agreed to reposition the post box but there may be a delay due to current restrictions. The Council have requested to be notified in advance so the new position can be agreed.
