

Fox and Hounds Lane between Foulsham and Themelthorpe

As near neighbours of Foulsham and Themelthorpe you might be interested in a community initiative called 'Reclaim the Lane', that is aiming to address the destruction of the above unsurfaced County Council maintained road by applying to have it reclassified to exclude motorised vehicles. During the various lockdowns, when we all explored the countryside more from our doorsteps, many people noticed how quickly the surface of this green lane deteriorated when it was used by motorised vehicles. We also noticed more how important it is for the people who live here.



Our initial approach was to speak to Norfolk Highways who closed the lane for a year under emergency procedures because its surface was (and is) dangerous. This will give them an opportunity to repair it and they have already deposited 180 tonnes of crushed concrete on a stretch of only about 100m at the Themelthorpe end. They are currently waiting for it to dry out sufficiently before they continue. Unfortunately, the road closure has not deterred some green laners from using it illegally and the surface has deteriorated further. Particularly when it has rained the lane is not usable by walkers, cyclists and horse riders at all. 4x4 vehicles have made water filled ruts that are over 50cm deep in places and motorbikes have created narrow, uneven tracks in the middle.

In addition, water mixed with clay makes for a very slippery surface, so hopping from good spot to good spot really isn't an option. The Green Party candidate in the last local election, Sarah Morgan, said she was saddened by the destruction when she visited last month, as are many other local people. Please take a look for yourself if you think this description must be an exaggeration. We want to reclaim the lane for the 3/4 of potential users who are currently unfairly excluded from it and are supported in this attempt by our MP Jerome Mayhew, County and District Councillor Greg Peck and the new Police and Crime Commissioner Giles Orpen-Smellie. It will cost us £8500 and the outcome is not guaranteed to go in our favour. Despite this, and despite lockdowns and social distancing, over 60 people have raised enough money in only six weeks to bring us within £3000 of the total. The strength of feeling for this lane in the community is huge.
